Wednesday, October 23rd was Unity Day. Everyone was encouraged to wear orange to Unite for Kindness, Acceptance and Aloha!


STEM Cars Club



Ali'iolani's STEM Cars Club has been chosen to be the 2019-2020 recipient of the Mark Takai Transition Grant. Thanks to our Head Custodian Terry Urata and his daughter Traci Urata for applying for the grant, the STEM Cars club will be honored with \$20,000. This money is going to be used for the clubs programming. During the first quarter the students learned how to carve and paint wood to create pine derby cars. During the second and third quarter the students will learn how to 3D print, build engines, and chassis and learn how to gear cars for a slot car track. During the 4th quarter students will work with partners to be able to work on remote control cars and race them against their peers. Daily skills that focus on communication, teamwork, and problem solving are touched upon daily. With the ultimate goal of working on a real car, the plan is to teach our students real world skills in a fun and engaging environment. We are so proud of the award and excited for our students.



Congratulations to the winners of the Pine Derby Race! First place: Gabriel, Second Place: Megumi, and Third place: Yinyi.






