



Dear Parents/Guardians.

Before we can party however our students will face their toughest challenge of the year. The state assessment for 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students will be during April. These tests assess our students' knowledge based on the Common Core State Standards. I feel confident that our students will do well as they have been progressing throughout the year.

A Message from our Principal



The Smarter Balance test will test our students on their knowledge of reading and math and science for our 4th Graders. What your child is learning on a daily basis builds the foundation for being able to demonstrate high achievement on tests. The following thoughts will help you in preparing your child for being ready each day.

The Night Before:

- Help your child get to bed on time. Research shows that being well rested helps students do better.
- Help children resolve immediate arguments before going to bed. Keep your routine as normal as possible.
- Mention the test to show you are interested, but don't dwell on it.
- Plan ahead to avoid conflicts on the morning of the test.

The Morning of the Test:

- Get up early to avoid rushing. Be sure to have your child at school on time.
- Have your child eat a good breakfast but not a heavy one. Research shows that students do better if they have breakfast before they take tests.
- Have your child dress in something comfortable.
- Be positive about the test. Explain that doing your best is what counts.
- Our testing schedule for the Smarter Balance test will run from April 23 to May 1.


